

SPSurDef.ini AutoConfig Tool


Multi-client, Abstract Displays configuration

Presentation

This program is a configuration tool for multi-client (multi IGs) abstract displays. It lets you add Clients via IP address and automatically retrieves their connected displays then generates SPSsurDef.ini File in its default location.

Manual


1. Connect your clients (IGs) to the same network, and make sure they are up and running with Vioso Calibrator launched and configured on each.
2. Open "SPSsurDef Remote Config.exe"

3. Add your first client: Choose a "Name" and type in its "IP address" in the corresponding fields.

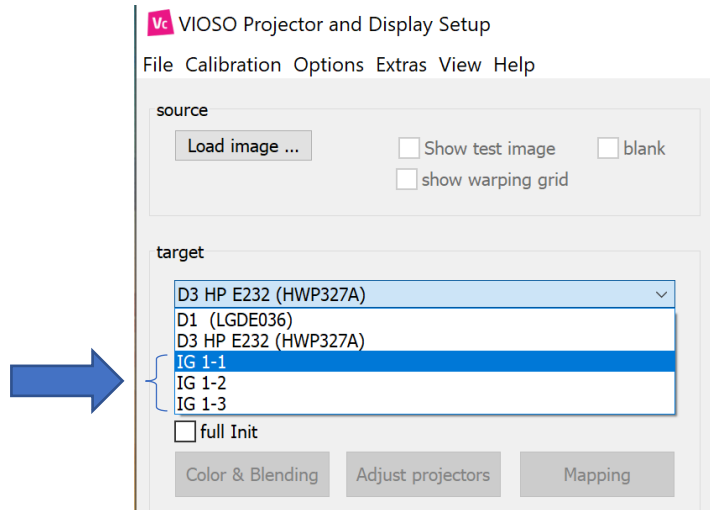
5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 until you've added all your clients.
6. Click the "Apply" button to save and complete the configuration.

The console will display "Remote Configuration Completed".

Now open your Vioso Software and you should see your displays in the “target” menu available for calibration:



Notes

- Displays detected are automatically named in this format “ [ClientName] – [DisplayNumber] ”.
- “Reset” button lets you reinitialize SPSSurDef.ini and start over again.
- Don’t forget to click the “Apply” button before you exit to save your configuration.
- Unable to Add client Error: The program will try to connect to the address provided with a timeout of 4 seconds. In case of failure It will show an error message, then please check your setup and network connection.
